Re: Kabaddi World Cup

Before half term, children in Year 3 took part in an arts and cultural workshop with Wolverhampton Art Gallery to design and make flags to celebrate the upcoming Kabaddi World Cup.

The Kabaddi World Cup (KWC) – West Midlands 2025 will be held in March 2025, welcoming the world's best kabaddi players from men's and women's teams from across the five member continents of World Kabaddi, including Africa, Asia, Oceania, Pan America and Europe. Teams from India, China, Iran and Pakistan as well as home nation teams from England and Scotland will compete for the World Cup, the first time the competition has been hosted outside of Asia.

We are very fortunate to have been gifted **30** tickets to attend the Kabaddi World Cup opening ceremony. As we have only been given a limited amount of tickets, and therefore cannot take the whole year group, we are offering this opportunity on a first come, first serve basis.
