A residential visit to Conover Hall, Shrewsbury has been planned for our Year 6 pupils. This will be an amazing opportunity for children to take part in a variety of outdoor activities including: archery, rock climbing, zip wire and much more.

The total cost per child for this visit is £152. School budgets **CANNOT** fund this visit and therefore, we are asking for **£91 per pupil** for this visit to go ahead.

Our flagship activity centre set in the Shropshire countryside offers the ideal combination of outdoor and indoor adventurous activities.

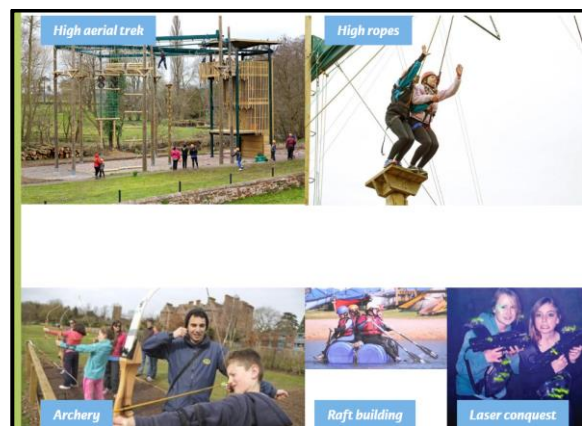

This allows instructors to get to know the strengths, weaknesses and personality of each child, supporting children in getting the most out of their time with JCA. It also helps ensure children are properly supervised at all times in accordance with our stringent safety programme.
