The morning session

Doors will be opened by a member of staff at 8.30am, if you require your children to be in school earlier, please use our breakfast club which begins at 7.30am.

Doors will close at 8.40am and any pupil entering school after this time will need to use the late door. If your child is late during our morning session the children will need to use this door not the main entrance. Mrs Jones will be there to support and answer any questions about attendance.

End of the school day

There will be no changes to where children enter and leave school. Children will finish school at the new time of 3.30pm and be released to parents. At 3.40pm children will be taken to lates and parents will be phoned. If children are not collected or parents contacted by 3.50pm children will be put into ACES our after-school club and charges will have to be paid.

If you would like to collect your child between 1.30pm-3.30pm on a Friday, please enter school through the main Fallings Park Lane entrance as other entrances will not be accessible.
